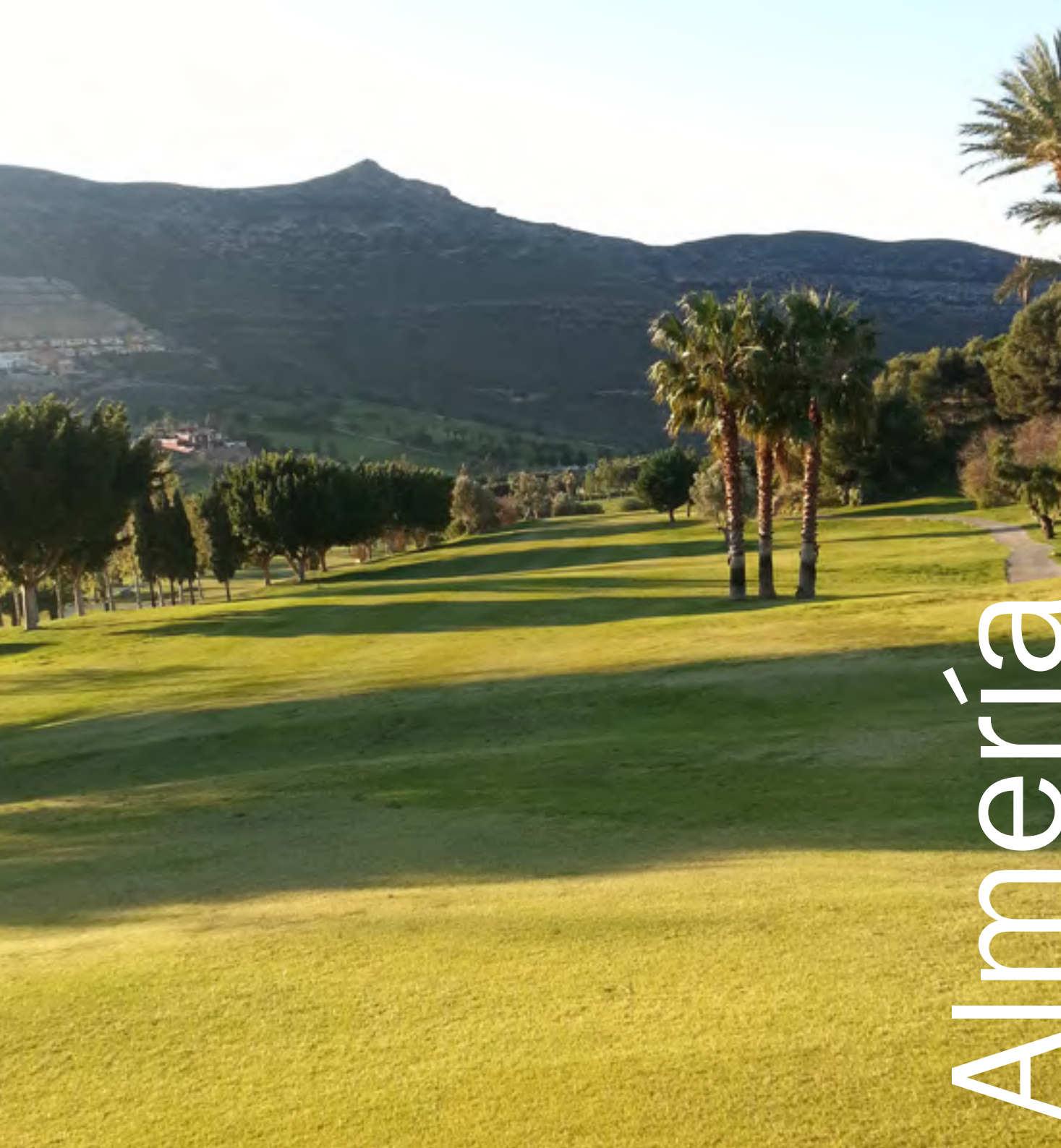

Playing golf in Almería is an unforgettable experience due to its climate, as it has more than 3,000 hours of sun a year, which means that you can play golf at any time of year.

The golf courses are magnificent, with very well-cared-for facilities, found in a unique setting and different surroundings, not very common amongst golf courses, as it is a province that is partially desert. The golf courses are watered well, thanks to an intelligent use of the water and a careful selection of the plants, allowing for a perfect and sustainable maintenance.

Its location allows for quiet golf courses, because Almería is very well communicated, however it keeps its distance from the busy world of hustle and bustle. The golf courses in Almería are an oasis in the middle of the desert, or orchards next to untouched beaches. Players of all levels and from different countries are found on these golf courses all year round, because here, golf has no limits.

Golf Aguilón makes the most of the complex, rugged terrain in an intelligent way that allows you to enjoy a spectacular golf course.

There is more to Almería than just the golf courses, because it is a natural and cultural treasure. A large part of the province is semi-desert, whilst

other parts are full of agriculture, an aspect that turns this region into one of the most important production centres of fruit and vegetables in Europe.

After playing golf, you can get to know the more than two hundred kilometres of coast, from **Pulpí** to **Adra**, with a great variety of pristine beaches that are mixed with landscapes consisting of mountain ranges, cliffs and sand dunes.

You can visit the pristine beach of **Las Amoladeras**, the sand dunes of the **Torre García beach**, cliffs like those of **Torre del Pirulico**, where there is an ecosystem dominated by exotic coral, or the mountain range of **Los Filabres**.

You will not find many provinces in Spain that have such a diverse orography, and this is precisely where the real charm of the golf courses in Almería can be found, located across a great variety of settings. Therefore, you can play whilst looking for inspiration in the delightful sea breeze of

the Mediterranean, or if you prefer, imagine yourself in the middle of an oasis. Some of them are designed copying the style of the desert golf courses in America, but whilst conserving its own native vegetation.

We recommend that you pay a visit to the **Natural Park of Cabo de Gata-Níjar**, an idyllic place with clear waters and immaculate beaches, where you can enjoy a spot of sunbathing or enjoy a dip in one of its secluded coves, like that of **Carbón** or **Príncipe**. With much more than 60 kilometres of coastline, it is reason enough to go for a walk or cool down, as its cliffs and seas, of unprecedented richness and beauty, or its species of flora and fauna, some of which are in danger of extinction, as is the case of the Dama gazelle, Barbary sheep, the spur-thighed tortoise or the black vulture, make this setting a unique place to lose oneself. One of the options within the park is to go to **San José de Níjar**, which has a marina where you can enjoy taking a walk to get to know the nearby surroundings aboard a sailing boat. If you want to get to know the areas inland, you can visit the **Cortijo del Fraile**, which is where the events that inspired the *Bodas de Sangre* play by **Federico García Lorca** took place.



The historic centre of Almería offers cultural routes passing through buildings, historical places of interest, museums and archaeological remains, a reflection of the influence of civilizations that have passed through these

lands over the course of history. It is impossible to pass through the region without being overwhelmed by the legends of the Arab people, which once settled here for no fewer than eight centuries. A demonstration of this is the **Alcazaba**, visible from any part of the city, which invites you to take a look back in time and let your imagination wander through its three precincts. Since the 10th century and until today, it has kept stories that are worth getting to know within its walls or even stories to dream about. It is the largest citadel constructed by the Arabs in Spain. You can continue your route through other important parts of the city like the **Casa de los Puche** in the **Plaza de Bendicho**, the town hall, the **Casa de las Mariposas**, the **Cultural Casino** or the **Cervantes theatre**.

Vicar, Roquetas de Mar and **El Ejido**, located in the west of Almería are also very interesting places where you can enjoy your passion for golf and make the most of natural, culture and entertainment attractions that you will find nearby.

Cádiz is one of the best renowned places for golf courses. It is located at the southernmost point of Europe, between the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean, and very close to Africa.

The coastline, where you can find the majority of the golf courses, has magnificent beaches, in general large ones with fine, golden sand. They are golf courses that are open to the immensity of the sky and the sea, with a prodigious light that allows golfers to play at any time.

The golf lifestyle is intense in Cádiz, due to the variety of its well-cared-for golf courses and the strategic location in which they are found, where the designer has taken into account the utmost detail, so that players have a magnificent experience.

On the best golf courses of the province, many tournaments are held within the Professional European Circuit, like the **Volvo Masters**, which has been held for many years at the **Valderrama** golf club. Amongst other international tournaments, the **Ryder Cup** was held on its golf course in 1997, in two back-to-back sessions

the **World Golf Championships**, the **American Express Championship** and the **Andalusia Masters** of 2010 and 2011.

The **Masters Open** of Andalusia has been held for three consecutive years at the **Montecastillo** golf club.

On the golf courses of the **San Roque Club**, **Guadalmina** and the **Sotogrande** club, the **European Tour Qualifying School Finals** have taken

place. The **MacGregor Week**, **European Tour Training School** and the **Spanish Open** in Andalusia have also been held at **San Roque** for two consecutive years.

The **Turespaña Masters** was held at the **Novo Sancti Petri**.

Cádiz surprises everyone who decides to visit it. Amongst the main attractions of this province, we should highlight the 260 km of coastline, more than a score of protected natural spaces and five regions of exceptional beauty. In a land full of wonders, play-

ing golf surrounded by beautiful beaches and pretty scenery is a privilege.

In addition to offering its visitors all types of entertainment, the capital city has culture on offer in the form of historic places of interest, museums and activities, and of course, history, as this is the oldest urban area in the West.

You can see the **Roman Theatre** or the **Baluarte de la Candelaria** in the capital city, the old fishing market at the **Puerto de Santa María** or the **Callejón del Arco** at the **Puerto Real**, for example. The influence of the constant exchange with the New World and the rest of the nations that have passed through here have strongly characterised the city, in terms of its traditions and festive celebrations, its gastronomy and even its open character. You can enjoy taking walks and visits full of the ecological richness of six Natural Parks: **Bahía de Cádiz, La Breña and Marismas de Barbate, Sierra de Grazalema, Los Alcornocales, Estrecho** and **Espacio Natural Doñana**. You will find woods, dunes or mountains, together with the charm of its quiet beaches. The Mediterranean Sea and Atlantic Ocean come together in Cádiz, as well as the Costa del Sol and the Costa de la Luz, its greatest value being offering visitors a true

paradise, based on untouched beaches and spots perfect to unwind and relax.

With this marvellous setting, it is not surprising that thousands of golfers travel to Cádiz to experience its splendour, just like Brett Rumford, Julien Quesne,



Francesco Molinari, Nicolas Colsarts and other professional golfers have done, who have achieved some of their most important victories here as well as contributing, in some cases, to the design itself of some of the courses.

The **Campo de Gibraltar**, located to the south east of Cádiz, is one of the best places to play golf and enjoy some leisure time. In **Tarifa**, the purity of its long beaches and the fact that it is considered the best place in Europe for wind sports like windsurf and kite surf, means that here you will also find the best boutiques, specialised shops, and also pubs, restaurants, workshops, crafts and a multitude of options to have a pleasant time.

Another option is to delve deeper into the world of equestrian sports and the cattle ranches of fighting bulls, which you will find nearby, or you can enjoy the nature of the **Estrecho Natural Park**, from where you can contemplate Africa just 14 km away. From here you can take boat trips and see cetaceans. You can also visit the Roman city at the foot of the **Baelo Claudia** beach.

The mosque, the **historical centre** and the **Patios** are all World Heritage sites. The **Mosque** is an immense building that is supported by 850 columns. Its colossal dimensions served to reflect the power that the city had achieved. This city has other surprises in store, all found within reach of the Mosque. The labyrinth of the **Jewish Quarter**, with its enchanting narrow, paved streets, where the light has a special tone. The **synagogue**, the historical monument for **Maimonides**, the picturesque, popular architecture, the explosion of colour from the flowers up on balconies, and each corner will transport you to a time in which three cultures, Christians, Jews and Muslims were capable of living together in peace and harmony.

If you are a lover of equestrian sports, Córdoba offers you a multitude of experiences, like a visit to the **Royal Stables**, in which shows are also offered and Andalusian horses are the protagonists. If you feel like relaxing, then you could go to see a show, as the city has an important network of theatres, ranging from the **Gran Teatro** to other pretty precincts

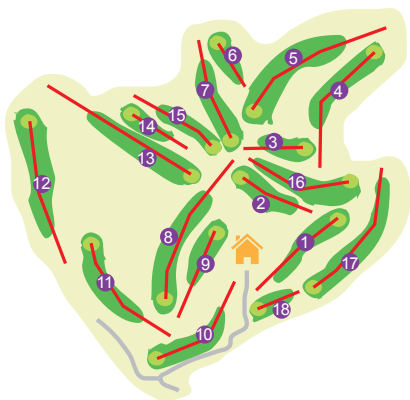

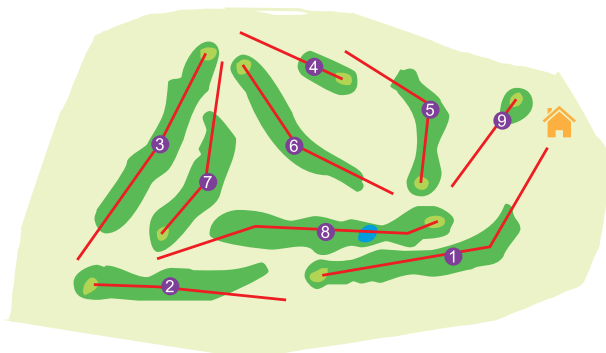

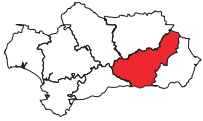

Despite it being a mountainous and abrupt landscape, in general, the golf courses are extremely well located.

Granada has magnificent golf courses in settings of surprising natural wealth, with cultural heritage and its endless options for tourism and well-being.

Whilst you play golf you can contemplate the impressive scenery that is dominated by the summits of the highest mountains of the Iberian Peninsula.

It was where Muslims settled for the longest amount of time in the Spanish Peninsula, and where they left their stamp of outstanding beauty that can be enjoyed after playing golf.

The importance of the **Alhambra** palace and the nearby **Generalife** means that they have been recognised as World Heritage sites. The **Alhambra** is an impressive palace district built on a hill, on which there are not only remains of the Nazarite splendour, but also of the **Renaissance palace of the Emperor Carlos V**. This whole historical district accumulates more than six hundred years of history. Next to the Alhambra palace you can find the **Generalife**, which was a place of rest for the Muslim Kings and from where they could watch over the city whilst

they listened to the murmur of water. The **Albaicín** district, on the other side of the river, is also a World Heritage site. It is a colourful district with Arabic characteristics and unbeatable views of the Alhambra. Its narrow streets form a labyrinth where you can get lost in its history and visit the Nazarite wall, the **Puerta de las Pesas**, the **Puerta Elvira**, the **palace of Dar al-Horra** or **El Bañue-**

lo, amongst other places of interest.

The **Sacromonte** was traditionally the neighbourhood belonging to the gypsies, which surprises visitors with its caves that have been excavated in the mountain.

The interior of the **Cathedral of Granada** is a treasure of Renaissance art, whilst the front of the building is a work of art in a baroque style. Next to the cathedral is the **Royal Chapel**, which houses the remains of the **Catholic Kings**.

The capital city is near to the golf courses and offers almost endless

cultural heritage and entertainment. However, the whole province is full of possibilities and options for trips out.

Baza, Guadix, Alhama de Granada, Loja, Montefrío, Orce, Huéscar, Almuñécar or **Salobreña** are examples of architectural heritage in the province. More than just a tourist destination, Granada is a journey of self-discovery for those that visit it, an adventure through beautiful spots where time comes to a stop.

Sierra Nevada, very close to the capital city, is the southernmost resort for winter sports in Europe and has more than 100 km of ski slopes. The good climate means that you can ski in the morning and play golf in the afternoon, for example. These sloping mountains are full of paths that lead to extraordinary places, for anyone who wants to go walking and get back to nature.

Costa Tropical, with more than 70 km of coastline, is also close to the golf courses, which means that you can combine activities. The average temperature of this area is 20°C and it has 320 days of sun a year. Its fantastic micro-climate guarantees that you will enjoy playing golf all year round. On the coast you will find a mix of long beaches and small coves between cliffs, so that each visitor can find

whatever it is that best suits their preferences.

Further inland in the province there are towns where it seems that time has stopped, with rural characteristics. If you like hiking, then you can walk through the villages of **La Alpujarra**, a group



of peaceful valleys and dramatic cliffs that descend from the summits of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Its villages conserve the stamp of the Islamic style and are found at different heights, which is why each one has a different character. Here is where you will find **Trevélez**, the highest village in Spain, at 1,476 metres above sea level. La Alpujarra is one of the areas in Europe with the largest extent of legally protected land, due to its immense natural importance. Hiking, cycling, horse riding routes or paragliding are some of the activities you can do in this area.

Perhaps it is due to the persistent Arabic legacy that you can find excellent spas in this province. The culture of health and well-being with water has always been maintained in this land full of natural springs. Heading towards **Ronda** you will find masses of pine forests and chestnut trees. You could stop in **Genalguacil**, a picturesque village that has an outdoors museum.

Enthusiasts of bull fighting cannot miss several places of interest in Seville on offer to them. On the fields of this province the first livestock of fighting bulls were initiated. Visiting some of them, you will be able to delve deeper into this legendary universe. Of course the culture that surrounds this topic extends to many more places that make for possible visits, like the bull ring, bull fighting schools or exhibition halls. The famous **Maestranza**, next to the Guadalquivir and the **Torre del Oro**, is a must-see in the city, as it is one of the most important bull rings with the greatest bull fighting tradition in Spain. Adjacent to the ring there are statues of the most successful bull fighters. You can visit the bull fighting museum where you will have a fascinating tour through the history of this art, by means of posters, drawings, photos, sculptures and other very interesting objects.

The area where the **cathedral** is found, the **Giralda**, the **Archivo de Indias** and the **Alcázar** palace, are all World Heritage sites, making them all well worth a visit. The Giralda was the old minaret of the mosque, and now it is

the bell tower of the cathedral, one of the largest of Christianity. Very nearby, in the **Plaza del Triunfo**, you will find the Archivo de Indias, which was founded as the House of Merchants. On the other side of the Avenida de la Constitución you will find



La Moneda, which was where the gold brought back from America was minted until the activity of minting coins was consolidated.

It is also very interesting to visit the **Plaza del Salvador**, the **town hall** and the **Plaza de San Francisco**.

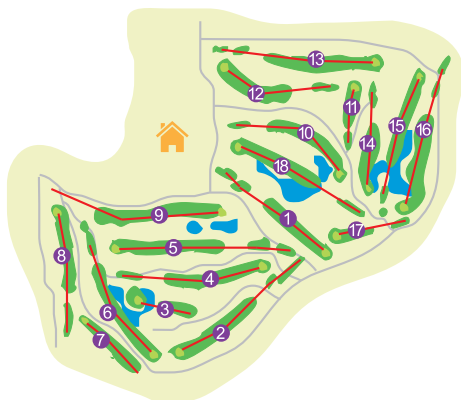
A clear example of the modern architecture of the city can be seen in the **Metropol Parasol** of the **Plaza de la Encarnación**, built on one of the oldest areas of the city. There are also modern examples of the architecture in the bridges, like that of the **Barqueta** or the **Alamillo**, and in the business area of the **Isla de La Cartuja**.

If you feel like unwinding and getting back to nature and some fresh air, you can walk through the **Sierra Norte** and follow a gastronomic route that runs through its villages. In the Natural Park itself of the Sierra Norte, you will be able to go to one of the most visited natural sights of the area, the **Cerro del Hierro**, located in the town of **San Nicolás del Puerto**, where the karstic scenery will be brought to your attention.

The central and well communicated golf courses of the province of Seville will allow you to combine the game with culture, shopping, well-being, all provided by an extraordinary city.

Golf Las Minas is found in a surprisingly beautiful setting, very close to the Corredor Verde of Guadiamar.

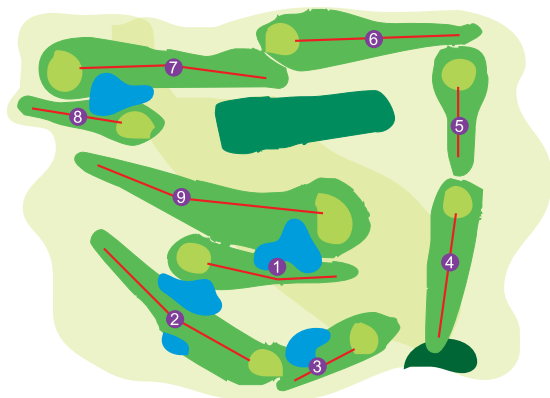

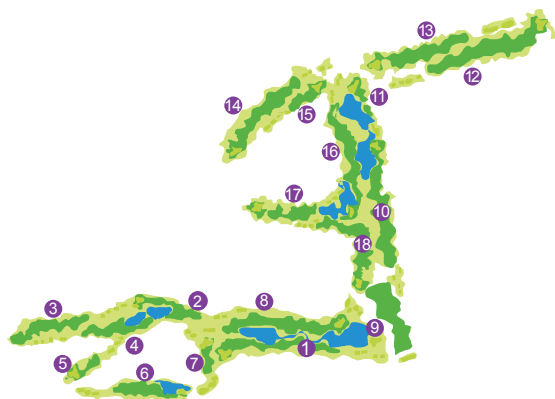

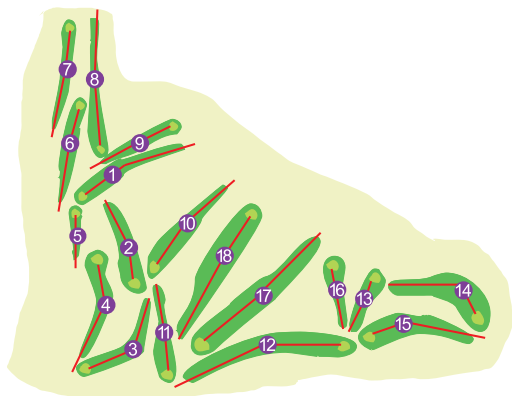
